### Hack4Future creates amazing learning, collaboration and networking opportunities:


- Inspiring 2 days at one of the biggest smart cities and tech hubs in the region Ülemiste City

## Hack4Future format

Duration: 2 days (15.-16.04.2020)
Participants: 70 students (35 from Estonia, 35 from abroad)
Teams: 21 teams (3-4 students per team)
Challenges: 7 pre chosen challenges from Ülemiste City campus companies
Solutions: 3 solutions to each case from 21 teams
Mentors: 6-8 (IT, bizdev, UX/UI, marketing, product development)

## Pitching and selecting winners

### Pitching

- All teams get to pitch their solutions on the Future Forum main stage
- The winning teams are selected by a jury of internal and external experts + all participants can vote via app
- Successful teams can partner with sponsor companies to develop their ideas further

### **Evaluation criteria**

- Progress during the hackathon
- Idea potential/impact/scalability
- Team collaboration

## Costs
