Description of the workshop accoridng to the grant agreement:

Learning Activity: Workshop Training on Sustainable Hospitality Digitalisation for Hospitality VET Learners.

Type: blended mobility learning.

The main focus of this blended learning workshop is on exploring innovations and sustainable hospitality digitalisation practices in Italy. The goal is to try the elements of the developed resources for VET learners in mixed learning environment and field trips prior to final OER mass publishing simultaneously increasing capacity of digital skills. 2 days of workshop will take online seminar with invited speakers (VET professionals) and testing the fragments of PR3 Sustainability Hospitality Digitalisation Course. Local VET students can be the parts of this training to create mixed cultural environment in terms of sustainability concepts. The 3 days of workshop will be for site visits to get experiences on local sustainable hospitality digitalisation practices, and will disseminate the developed project materials. The blended mobility will improve sustainable hospitality digitisation skills, enable exchange of international practices and meet local representatives running the digitalisation and innovations in hospitality. During this workshop, 1 Accompanying person, VET educator will join VET learners to organise effective international staff capacity of trained VET educators in sustainable hospitality digitalisation. Each educator will deliver a different session and will be the speaker during the workshop on sustainable hospitality practices and innovations. Also the educator will guide the VET learners during sustainable hospitality site visits including observation of digitalisation practices. The workshop training hosting and organising partners is project coordinator Italian Hospitality School SRL with competence to host educational training and can help in arranging affordable accommodation in Rome for attendees. Affordable accommodation and cultural programme can be arranged in Rome with respect to the allowed budget. Italian Hospitality School will organise all activities to help participants to arrange living, catering, cultural events while stay in Rome, Italy and will prepare cultural profile of the country and travel, hosting manual for the training. Italian Hospitality School will develop the programme of daily workshop sessions, field trips, cultural events to get additional insights on sustainable hospitality digitalisation in Italy. After the workshop, participant will be asked to provide survey feedback, attendance will be registered in attendance register. Feedback will be analysed for final report and possible amendments to Open educational Resources. The participants will receive certificates of participation in the workshop training for VET learners with attended hours and EUROPASS Mobility certificates.
